Ninilchik

- I am court-ordered to treatment and have no reliable way to get to and from Kenai.
- I think having service available would be very beneficial to our community.
- I think public transportation should be available in all communities. However, this is not so on the Kenai Peninsula. I believe public transportation would be highly beneficial for Ninilchik's seniors and youth. There is a definite need for it here!
- I would like the people-mover bus service to expand its work throughout the Kenai peninsula. I would also love to see more vehicles so it can have more pick-up times and not just a couple throughout the day. This would help out a lot of people and also bring more business to the cities.
- I would like to see a bus or van in Ninilchik; not only Homer Stage Coach.
- I would like to see bus service to Kenai, Soldotna, for shopping, medical and treatment.
- My son is handicapped and has gotten many job offers and volunteer positions in the Kenai, Soldotna AK. But due to my husband's and my schedule we can't get him up to a job or volunteer position. It would be nice to have CARTS or some service come here to help MANY people out getting to work or town.
- Need help getting to medical and shopping. Health dictates I cannot drive that far.
- No bus services. Service would be nice.
- Please create one!
- Reasonably priced daily service for Homer to Kenai and Soldotna, at least for college campus and elderly.
- Rides to school (college). Transportation to town and back.
- Since we have no bus services, something would be good. A trip and and back to the college or doctors; a schedule once a day during the week Monday-Friday would be reasonable.
- Something is better than nothing.
- There currently are no transportation services in Ninilchik.
- There is no public transportation in the area. Gas is SO expensive. Travel is dangerous. There are many people in our area that would benefit from this service. We need our state to fund public transportation.
- To have one that will take us to and from Kenai and Soldotna.
- We are in need of SOME sort of public transportation. My grandmother would utilize it. Not to mention if my car breaks and I'm stranded. Public transportation would help so much. And it's eco-friendly!

- We don't have a bus service now. There are a lot of elderly people in our community who would benefit from a bus service. Gas is very expensive! Winter conditions can be hazardous!
- We have NO bus service! Travel is dangerous in winter. Our community would benefit greatly. I would ride the bus.
- We have no bus service.
